Judge's Comments:

I would like to thank the Society for inviting me to judge the 2008 National in Lansing, Michigan. I was asked to judge the Peachfaced Division. This proved to be a joy and very enlightening!

The quality of the birds was exceptional. The progress made over the past few years is amazing.

I was most impressed with the progress of the Orangefaced in both Australian Cinnamon and in the Opaline. The original Aust. Cinnamon we received in the 80's was not a large bird. As most of you know the Opalines have been small birds in the past years, but now we have birds that are very good size and width of body even in the Orangefaced. The problem of tubular (narrow) bodies from the beginning of this mutation has often hurt its placement at Bird Shows. The birds at this year's National have certainly broken that mold. The birds I judged had exceptional width and body type.

Violets have been near or at the top bench for several years now. We saw three beautiful ones this year, two Whitefaced and one Australian Cinnamon – all exceptional birds.

We also had a few lovely Pieds. This is a mutation that has suffered in the recent years. Hopefully, we will see more interest in showing these birds. It is difficult getting both size, type and to that add the challenge of perfect symmetrical markings – but well worth the effort.

There were three Champions, all good and in First Place (no surprise) was an exceptional Whitefaced Medium Violet.

It was a good entry of one hundred and forty four birds.

Congratulations to everyone who participated – you are all doing your job. This kind of progress makes it all worthwhile.
